BECOME OFFICIAL! **April-21-2021** is the day we are set to leave thanks to your prayers and support!

As many of you know, my older brother John is the Pastor of [Bible Believers Baptist Church in Hillsboro, OR](#). After knowing of our intention to return to the field for quite some time, and having prayed for us in the matter, he called and more or less asked me “what the hold up is”. I explained the financial restraints that were keeping us from being able to purchase tickets and make other necessary arrangements to return to the field. He asked me if my supporters know of our needs. My response was that the Lord knew and that I hesitate to mention our financial needs in our prayer letters because mission work is littered with “moochinaries” who always “need more money”. After giving me sound counsel on the matter, in his zeal for the Lord, he almost immediately started an [online fundraising campaign](#), organized through their local church, mentioning that it would allow the saints to “carry us forward” on our journey “after a godly sort”, “lacking nothing”. **We have been blown away to see the Lord’s people step up to help us get back to the field** in downright quick order! I told Jennie that we must have been a bigger pain in the backside than we realized because you all are scrambling at the chance to get us out of here! All kidding aside, I believe that most of our supporters know and understand, as we do, that the time is short to work before the Lord comes and that the work must be done while opportunity remains. Within 24hrs we received enough one time support to be able to purchase tickets, and to pull out all the stops to making arrangements to head over to Malawi.

“Excited”, does not even begin to describe how we feel and “thankful” almost seems to be an understatement. Your generosity and care for lost souls around the world makes me thankful to be your missionary and to fulfill my part in your ministry in Malawi. May the Lord richly bless all who are financially making our soon return possible. May he also equally bless those many of you, who I have met over the years, who rejoice with us in the Lord’s provision, but don’t have the means to give towards this endeavour. I hope you know that we deeply appreciate your prayers for our family and the ministry which the Lord would have us fulfill.

As if this was not hard enough to believe, we also received a call from one of our supporting church pastors. He informed me that the Lord had given his church some missions funding, and that God put it on his heart to PURCHASE A VEHICLE for us when we get back to the field! ***I am blown away by what GOD is doing!*** Most of the time I am not the smartest guy in the room, but even I can see that GOD’s time has come!

After working, believing, and acting as though we had things set in order to go, **God has moved and so now we are going**. As you know, finances are only a necessary tool to help enable the work of the ministry. The unseen enemies that seek to hinder us from boldly sowing the seed, as we ought and which seek to stop the eyes and ears of the lost masses from the “hearing of the word” must equally be moved out of the way. We are no more able to do that by ourselves than we were able to provide the funds for ourselves. So we go knowing that the spiritual condition of the world-wide atmosphere has changed forever, and that it is more opposed to the gospel of Jesus Christ than ever before. We go with a deeper sense than ever before of our need for his divine protection and the necessity for God to move in the ministries which he will fulfill by our hand.
